

## Summer Mathletics Program

Students entering 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Grades are expected to use the Mathletics program this summer to practice their math facts and keep their skills sharp. The program may be accessed by logging onto the St. Agnes School website, clicking on “Classes” and selecting the grade level they have just completed. Mathletics is linked to the class pages. Each child has been given a user name and password.

There are two on-line components to Mathletics that may be used during the summer months: the review modules and the live racing. The review modules consist of practice exercises in each major concept area taught per grade level. Printable workbooks are also available on St. Agnes School’s Mathletics webpage. These tools can be used as additional support to students who might be struggling with a concept, as well as a great review for all!

The live racing component is a fun, exciting, motivating way for your child to keep her/his math facts sharp. Students compete in a 60 second race against either the computer or against peers from around the world. There are increasing levels of difficulty to keep your child challenged. Points are earned and students are able to “spend” their points in various ways in the program. Parents can track their child’s participation, improvement and accuracy by accessing “My Report” on the Live Mathletics page.

We are urging you to have your child participate in the live racing activity this summer. All participants will be recognized and rewarded with a special treat in September. We are very excited about this program! We have witnessed the benefits first-hand during this school year and encourage your whole-hearted support. Happy summer and happy racing!
