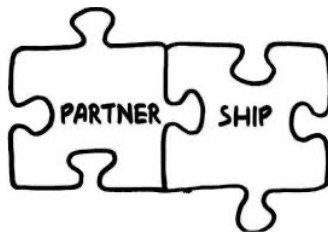

Principal's Thoughts

We are approaching the half-way point in the trimester and with that a Progress Report will be sent home on Friday, October 8th for students in grades K-5. This report is a way to communicate with you about your child's performance to date. You will have the opportunity to discuss this information further with your child's teacher, as well as areas of strength and needs for growth, during parent/teacher conferences scheduled for October 13th and 14th. Please be on the lookout for an email from your child's teacher via the online program Doodle to reserve a 15-minute block of time for your Zoom appointment. Teachers will be available from 1:00-8:00 on both days. When it is time for your appointment, just use the Zoom link provided to enter the waiting room. The teacher will be notified when you arrive and will bring the current conference to a close. Please be patient, the teacher will invite you into the conference as quickly as possible. Junior High families have regular access to the PowerSchool Parent Portal and therefore will not receive a paper Progress Report. Your student will receive an acknowledgement form indicating that you have checked the PowerSchool portal. We ask you to sign and return this form by the date indicated. Junior High parents will schedule their appointments with the Homeroom teacher. The teachers are looking forward to meeting with you to share their insights and goals for your children.

Disaster Drill Reminders

- This drill will take place Wednesday, October 6th and all families will need to participate. We will begin by practicing the Duck & Cover procedure and then assembling on the field for our check in routine.
- Please send a beach towel and hat with your child to use while on the field.
- Please provide something for your child to eat if your pickup time is after 12:30.
- **NO KIDS CLUB WILL BE OFFERED.**
- Families are asked to arrive according to the timetable listed below:
 - 11:00-11:15 Preschool

 - 11:45-12:00 HIJK

- All cars will enter in the driveway of the staff parking lot and follow the delineated path.
 - A check in table will be located by Fr. Johnson's backyard gate and you will be asked to stop here and show a photo ID (driver's license.)
