- Each year we are required to practice our disaster preparedness plan. This drill will take place Wednesday, October 6th and all families will need to participate. We will begin by practicing the Duck & Cover procedure and then assembling on the field for our check in routine.
- Please send a beach towel and hat with your child to use while on the field.
- Please provide something for your child to eat if your pickup time is after 12:30.
- Families are asked to arrive according to the timetable listed below:
 - 11:00-11:15 Preschool
 - 11:15-11:30 ABC
 - 11:30-11:45 DEFG
 - 11:45-12:00 HIJK
 - 12:00-12:15 LMNO
 - 12:15-12:30 PQRS
 - 12:30-12:45 TUVW
 - 12:45-1:00 XYZ
- All cars will enter in the driveway of the staff parking lot and follow the delineated path.
 - A check in table will be located by Fr. Johnson's backyard gate and you will be asked to stop here and show a photo ID (driver's license.)
 - After you have been checked-in you will be directed to pull into a pick-up lane and a staff member will bring your child(ren) to you.
- Only those identified on your Disaster Emergency form will be allowed to take your child(ren) off campus.
- Please do not walk on campus to pick-up your child(ren.) Thank you in advance for your cooperation!
