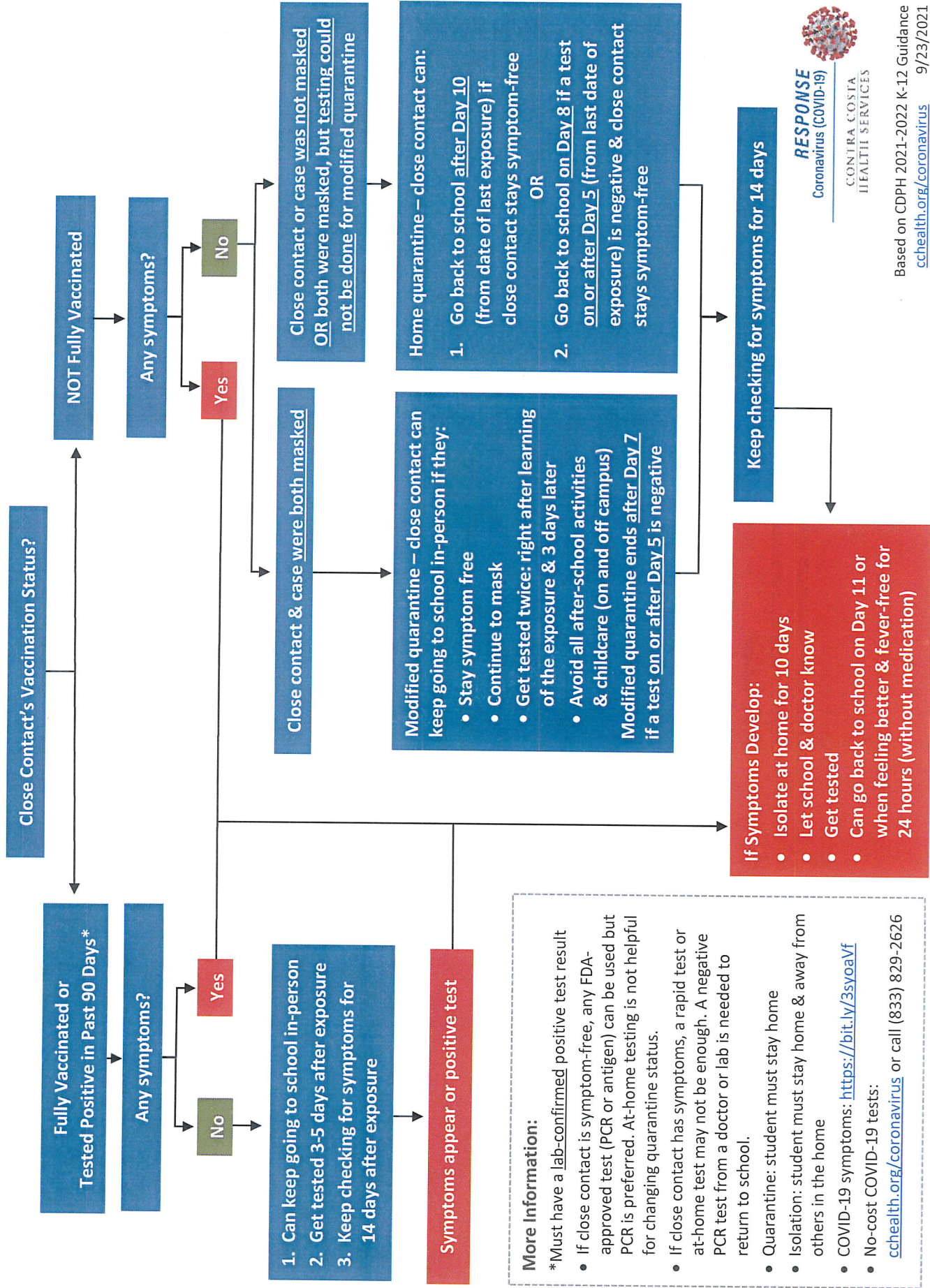


A Student was Exposed to COVID-19 at School: What's Next?



More Information:

- *Must have a lab-confirmed positive test result
- If close contact is symptom-free, any FDA-approved test (PCR or antigen) can be used but PCR is preferred. At-home testing is not helpful for changing quarantine status.
- If close contact has symptoms, a rapid test or at-home test may not be enough. A negative PCR test from a doctor or lab is needed to return to school.
- Quarantine: student must stay home
- Isolation: student must stay home & away from others in the home
