### Principal's Thoughts

Thank you for your commitment to Catholic education and re-enrolling your child(ren) for the 2022-2023 school year! This has been an interesting two years and your patience and support have not gone unnoticed. Now that we know the number of students enrolling, we can focus on preparing for next year. Currently we are creating our 2022-2023 budget. The finance committee and I continue to meet to review the expenses for this current year in comparison to the previous 4 years so we can realistically project expenditures for next year. This preliminary budget is due to the School Department by April 29<sup>th</sup>. Once this budget has been submitted, we will then begin ordering the learning materials and supplies for next year! The 5-year Capital Plan is also reviewed and revised to ensure adequate funds will be available when capital improvements are needed.

The 2022-2023 school calendar has been formalized. The first day of school will be Tuesday, August 23<sup>rd</sup> (8am-9:30am) and the last day is scheduled for Thursday, June 8<sup>th</sup> (8am-10am.) Christmas vacation will begin December 22<sup>nd</sup> and end on January 2<sup>nd</sup> with classes resuming Tuesday, January 3<sup>rd</sup>. It's hard to believe we are already at this point in the school year and looking toward August!
