### **Principal's Thoughts**

This coming Friday we have scheduled a school holiday (actual state holiday is tomorrow) to commemorate the life and work of Cesar Chavez who created awareness and an organization to fight for justice of the farmworkers that later became known as the United Farm Workers Union. He was born on March 31, 1927 to a farming family in Arizona. After losing the family farm during the depression, his family moved to Northern California to work as migrant farmworkers. This experience prompted him to work tirelessly for a just wage and safer working conditions.

The social teachings of the catholic church are centered around our commitment to the poor and building a just society which is often counter-culture to the challenges of modern society. There are seven teachings, all of which speak to the work of Cesar Chavez. One of those teachings in particular is the Dignity of Work and the Rights of Workers. According to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, "The economy must serve people, not the other way around. Work is more than a way to make a living; it is a form of continuing participation in God's creation. If the dignity of work is to be protected, then the basic rights of workers must be respected--the right to productive work, to decent and fair wages, to the organization and joining of unions, to private property, and to economic initiative."

Cesar Chavez worked tirelessly for better working conditions for this group of people that are so important

to the nation and our state's agricultural economy. This wasn't an easy task and he was not always popular however in 1994 he was posthumously awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom for his work. You might want to consider doing a community service activity to celebrate the day!

### Help Please~

- We are experiencing many children leaving during the day, particularly after lunch.
- o If possible, please try to schedule appointments on our minimum days so as to minimize disruptions and missed learning opportunities.

### Scrip Deadline Approaching

- o April 29th is the last day to purchase scrip to count toward your 2021-2022 family commitment.
- As described in the Family Handbook: "SCRIP is a mandatory program whereby each family is expected to purchase an amount of SCRIP in a year that generates at least \$300.00 in profit." If you:
  - Elect not to participate in the program, or minimally participate (\$100.00 in profit), you will be assessed a fee of \$500.00.
  - Generate between \$101 and \$150 in <u>profit</u>, you will pay the balance <u>plus</u> 30% of the \$300.00.
  - Generate between \$151 and \$200 in <u>profit</u>, you will pay the balance <u>plus</u> 20% of the \$300.00.
  - Generate between \$201 and \$299 in <u>profit</u>, you will pay the balance <u>plus</u> 10% of the \$300.00.
  - Generate over \$400.00 in profit, the additional amount will be divided equally between the school and you. This overage will be credited to your September/October tuition payments.

- As of March 24<sup>th</sup>, St. Agnes Church and School have collected 1,484 lbs. of food for the SHARE Food Pantry.
