The staff at St. Agnes School strongly believes that a positive learning atmosphere depends upon each student's help and cooperation. We have established school rules that are based upon an important second set of the three R's: Respect, Responsibility, and Resourcefulness. They are simple rules of common sense and courtesy. We know these rules help support an environment that promotes academic excellence, mutual respect among students and staff, and pride in self and school.

It is impossible to overemphasize the important role parent's play in letting their children know they will not accept inappropriate behavior. Parental support is by far the most significant factor in promoting courtesy and respect for self and others.

3. I will act appropriately, knowing that swearing, teasing, bullying, and using put-downs are inappropriate and not acceptable at our school.
4. I will keep my hands, feet, and other objects to myself.
5. I will not fight nor be involved in any roughhousing at school.
6. I will walk in all areas of the school and church, including the porch. I will walk on the blacktop area whenever possible.
7. I will behave in an orderly and polite fashion during lunchtime. I will consume snacks in the classroom only and will eat my lunch while sitting down at the tables.
8. I will not chew gum on campus or while accompanying my class on field trips.
9. I will have the necessary adult permission to be out of class.
10. I will come to school and class on time.
11. I will come to class prepared (homework, paper, pencil, required books, and materials).
12. I will follow the uniform and non-uniform dress code of our school.
13. I will respectfully participate in all school and church services.
14. I will promptly show my parents all written communications.
