

## PRESCHOOL UNIFORM

### UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

All articles of clothing should be clearly labeled with the child's name. The following is the list of uniform requirements:

#### **Girls:**

- o Hunter green and blue plaid jumper (Dennis Uniforms, Optional)
- o Navy blue or khaki pants, leggings, shorts, skirt, or skorts. No Jeans.  
(Leggings maybe worn by preschool children only)
- o Current year school spirit shirt
- o Hunter green or white polo type shirt with no print on front or back.  
Long sleeve or short sleeve. (St Agnes monogram Optional)
- o Navy blue cardigan
- o Fleece style jacket (Navy blue, black, or hunter green)
- o Navy blue sweatshirt with St. Agnes monogram (optional)
- o Socks must be worn at all times
- o White, black or navy blue plain-footed tights may be worn with skirts/jumpers
- o Any bows or headbands must be white, navy blue, hunter green, black or uniform plaid.
- o One flat post earring may be worn to school. No jewels or precious stones; gold or silver only. • If an earring falls out it will be placed in a sealed envelope; teachers will not reinsert earrings. • No hoops or any type of dangling earrings are allowed. • St. Agnes Preschool will not be responsible for lost earrings.
- o No other jewelry is permitted, except approved earrings and necklaces that are religious in nature (i.e., a blessed religious medal or cross).

#### **Boys:**

- o Navy blue or khaki cotton-twill pants or shorts. No jeans.
- o Current year school spirit shirt
- o Hunter green or white polo type shirt with no print on front or back.  
Long sleeve or short sleeve. (St Agnes monogram Optional)
- o Navy Blue cardigan
- o Fleece style jacket (Navy blue, black, or hunter green)
- o Navy blue sweatshirt with St. Agnes monogram (optional)
- o Socks must be worn at all times.
- o No jewelry is permitted, except approved necklaces that are religious in nature (i.e., a blessed religious medal or cross).

### **Shoes (Boys and Girls)**

: We recommend simple, closed toe and sturdy shoes. Velcro fastener shoes are practical and fosters independence.

#### **The following shoes are not allowed:**

: tie shoes (unless your child can tie themselves independently, high top shoes, shoes that light up, cowboy boots, boots, UGG boots/UGG Style boots, crocs, flip flops, open sandals, or rain boots.

### **Personal Appearance and Accessories**

- o Extreme haircuts or styles are not permitted including additional beading or feathers. Haircuts with tails are not allowed.
- o The length of a boy's hair must be short enough so as not to touch the shirt collar. A boy's hair length may not touch the eyebrows.

### **Rainy Weather Apparel**

- o No raincoats, rain boots or umbrellas are to be left inside the classroom.

### **NON-UNIFORM DRESS CODE**

The school uniform is worn each day unless specific permission is given for non-uniform dress.

*The following code will apply:*

Young children are very likely to act like the clothing in which they dress.

Clothing often influences the child's mode of operation and social interaction for the day. This draws the child from the kind of special experiences and cooperative play that are available at school.

- o Jeans are allowed on Non-uniform dress days ONLY
- o No clothing may be worn that has princess, superhero, TV or movie character identity. This includes jackets and shoes.
- o Dress your child in simple clothing, which he/she can manage by him/herself to help foster independence. Elastic waists are best
- o No belts or overalls.
- o Help your child dress appropriately for the weather.
