WHEN IS WHEEL-A-THON

Our annual Wheel-A-Thon will be held on Thursday, September 22, 2021. This is a half day and students will be dismissed at noon.

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE

Wheel-A-Thon is one of St. Agnes School's greatest fundraising efforts of the year! It is the **ONLY** event that raises money to finance educational field trips. Examples of previous field trips include: Caritas Creek Camp (5th) Monte Toyon (3rd), NASA facilities, Fort Ross, California Missions, Marine Mammal Center of Marin, The State Capital, Walnut Creek Performing Arts Center, and various cultural events.

WHO BENEFITS

The *STUDENTS* of St. Agnes School benefit directly and proportionally from the funds they raise. The money raised by each student is used for his/her own class to pay for field trips.

HOW DO WE CONTRIBUTE

Students are encouraged to seek contributions for the number of bicycle laps they ride during the Wheel-A-Thon. Contributors promise to make a tax-deductible donation per lap which the students collect after the event, or, if they prefer, contributors may make a donation in a pre-determined amount regardless of the number of laps. Be sure to check with your workplace since many offer matching contributions!

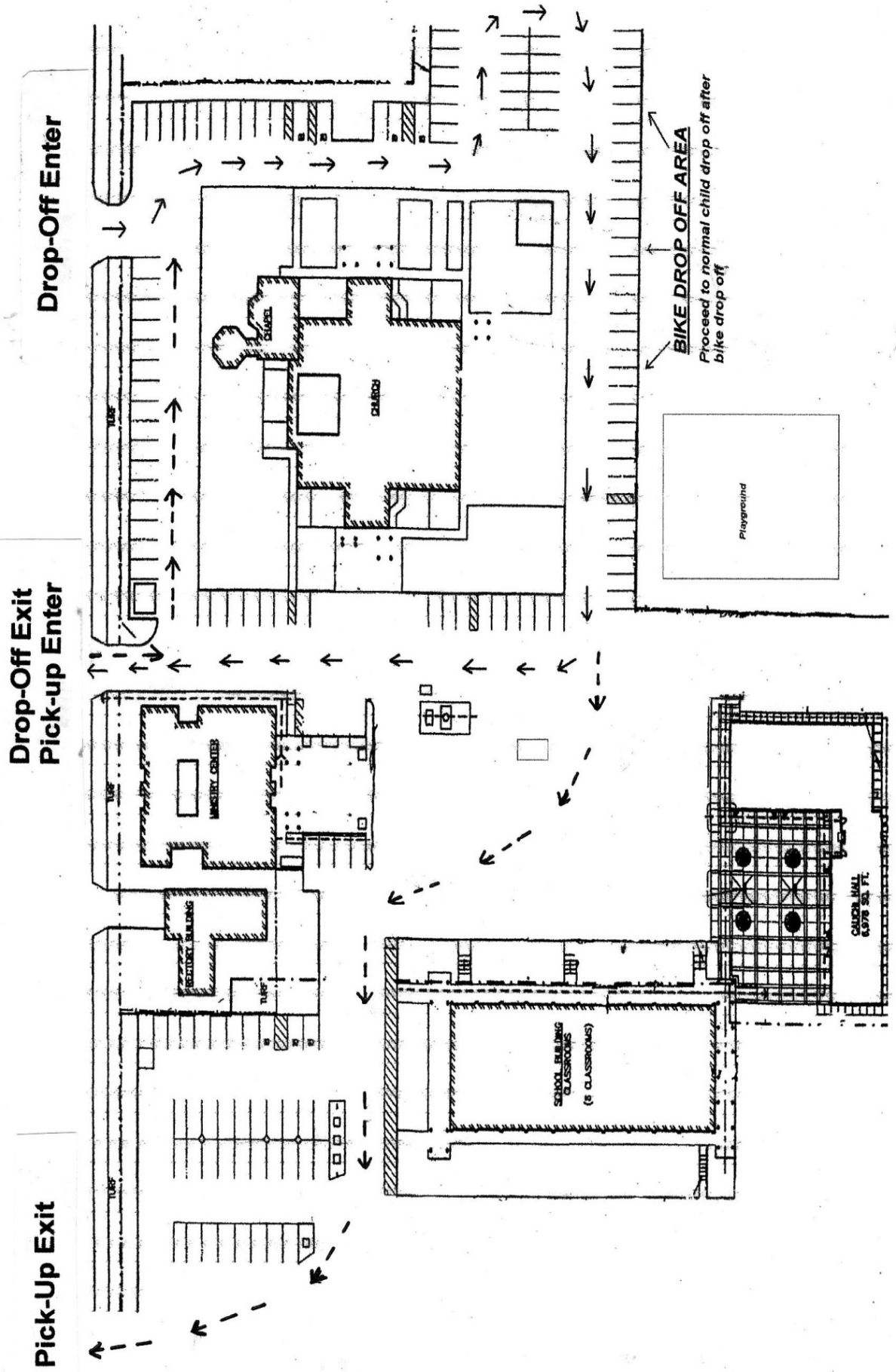
INCENTIVES & PRIZES

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- **Rider name must be placed on bike**, so it can be clearly seen **before** they are brought to school. (Use tape or a label to write name on bike & helmet)
- ALL bikes must be **walked** to and from track area!
- Every rider must wear a **helmet!**
- T-Track is available to those children in Kinder and 1st grade who ride bikes with training wheels. **No “Big Wheels” or scooters allowed.**
- As a safety precaution for all students, please make sure your child is proficient at riding the bike they bring to participate in the Wheel-A-Thon.
- **All children must have a parent or guardian’s signature on the permission form to ride in the Wheel-a-thon.**
- **We can NOT allow anyone without a signature to ride, due to liability concerns.**
