Principal's Thoughts

The first trimester has come to an end and we celebrate all the hard work the students have put forth. Report Cards will be sent home on Friday and I would like to especially direct your attention to the table titled: Work Habits/Social Development on the back page. A rubric listing the criteria for this table has been included in the report card envelope for you to review. This rubric helps clarify the criteria used to determine whether an "M" (consistently meets), "A" (approaching standard) or "N" (needs support) is marked. This information reflects the effort and commitment exhibited by each student as well as their social/emotional maturity. Please review this information with your child and discuss what their goal will be for the second trimester.

The standards-based report card for grades K-5 lists the essential standards for each core subject. There are multiple skills that are included within each standard. The number (grade) marked next to each, reflects what the student has learned. A "3" cannot be listed If instruction has not covered all the skill(s) associated with that essential standard or if the student has not exhibited mastery of every skill. If you would like more details or additional information, the Parent Guide to Standards Based Grading is posted on our website in the Resources and Forms section under the Parents tab. The traditional grading system with letter grades, is now only used on the Junior High Report Card, so that the information correlates with information needed by the high schools. With this in mind, we also use the California Junior Scholastic Federation criteria to determine First Honors for our awards assembly that is scheduled this for Friday before our Thanksgiving Prayer Service.
