The season of Advent begins this Sunday which also signals the commencement of a new liturgical year. The four week period of Advent is a time of preparation and prayer so that we can fully embrace the anniversary of Jesus' birth. We are also told to open our hearts, to be ready for the time we will encounter Jesus again. The word Advent comes from a Latin word meaning coming or arrival. The theme for the first week of Advent is Hope. One purple candle, known as the prophesy candle, is lit on the Advent Wreath to remind us God's promises, as described in the Old Testament, that Jesus would be born; a savior for the world.
