- 2. Acts may include but are not limited to: dancing, singing, playing an instrument, acting, poetry, comedy, magic etc.**
- 3. Students must comply to behavior expectations during auditions, rehearsals and performance. If students are disruptive, they will automatically be disqualified from the talent show.**
- 4. All themes must be appropriate for school. Any act that contains profanity, sexual language, suggestive sexual themes or violence will be disqualified.**

### **Preparedness –**

- ✓ Brought props and other necessities**
- ✓ Memorized song, words or choreography**
- ✓ Act is well rehearsed**
- ✓ Collaborative/teamwork**
- ✓ Stage Presence – Student is confident and engages the audience. Facial expression, body language and demeanor are professional.**
- ✓ Quality – Student sings, plays or otherwise performs at a level that definitely engages a middle school audience.**
- ✓ Appropriateness, content and language – The act is appropriate for a school sponsored event and may be viewed by a diverse audience.**

**I have read the above rules, and I agree to follow all rules of participation. In the event that I am unable to honor this contract, I will contact the talent show committee as soon as possible. I understand that if I fail to provide the lyrics, script, or music required for screening then I will not be allowed to participate. Participants must meet all deadlines for submissions and auditions to be considered eligible.**
