Disaster Drill Alert

- Each year we are required to practice our disaster preparedness plan. This drill will take place Wednesday, September 3rd. We will begin with pickup for our preschool families at 11:30.am The Drill will begin with students practicing the Duck & Cover procedure and then assembling on the field for our check-in routine.
- Please remember to apply sunscreen on the children before leaving the house and store hats and beach towels in backpacks.
- Students can bring food to eat if they are being picked up after 12:30.
- Families are asked to arrive according to the timetable listed below:
 - 11:00-11:30 Preschool
 - 11:30-11:45 MNO PQ
 - 11:45-12:00 RSTU
 - 12:00-12:15 VWXYZ
 - 12:15-12:30 ABC
 - 12:30-12:45 DEFG
 - 12:45-1:00 HIJKL
- All cars need to enter through the gate of the **staff** parking lot and follow the delineated path.
 - A check-in table will be located by Fr. Luke's backyard gate and you will be asked to stop there and show a photo ID (driver's license.)
 - After you have been checked-in you will be directed to pull into a pick-up lane and a staff member will bring your child(ren) to you.
- Only those identified on your Disaster Emergency form will be allowed to take your child(ren) off campus.
- No one will be allowed to walk on campus and pick-up students. Thank you in advance for your cooperation!

Thinking carefully before acting and then doing what God would want you to do.

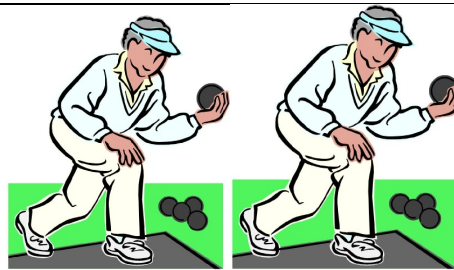


First Dine Out!
