

### **IMPORTANT NOTES**


- Participation fee of \$5 per rider
- Rider name must be placed on bike, so it can be clearly seen before they are brought to school. (Use tape or a label to write name on bike & helmut)
- During drop off, parents & kids stay in car while volunteers unload bikes
- During pick up, bikes will be loaded into vehicles and then cars will move into regular carline
- Every rider must wear a helmet!
- There are two tracks available to those children in Kinder through 2nd grade, a T-Track for those who ride bikes with training wheels, and a Small track for those on two wheels. No "Big Wheels", striders or scooters allowed.
- 3rd 8th grade will have one track available to those who ride. Only two wheel bikes allowed (no striders)
- As a safety precaution for all students, please make sure your child is proficient at riding the bike they bring to participating
- All children must have a parent or guardian's signature on the permission form to ride
- We can NOT allow anyone without a signature to ride, due to liability concerns.
- Pre-School children will walk the track and not ride, pick up and drop off will be at the flagpole
