Sunday, January 25th marks the beginning of Catholic Schools Week with Mass at 9am. This annual nationwide event was created by the National Catholic Education Association (NCEA) in 1974. Schools across the nation will celebrate not only their individual communities but Catholic education in general. Here's some interesting data: there are 5,852 Catholic schools in the US (4,683 of those schools serve elementary aged students.) Catholic high schools have a graduation rate of 98-6%. The percentage of Catholic high school graduates that attend a four-year college is 83.7% as opposed to 56.5% in non-sectarian schools and 60% in other affiliated religious schools.

Special Christmas Delivery!


